

Good afternoon!

I wanted to advise you that Dominion Transmission will ask FERC to terminate its pre-filing review process for the Storage Factory Project including the proposed Compressor Station in Frederick, Maryland. DTI has determined that additional time is required to finalize plans for leaching salt caverns, and for disposition of brine from the salt cavern development. As such, DTI plans to develop an alternative project scope to ensure that the Storage Factory Project customers receive the promised service by 2014. DTI will file a revised project scope in a few years, designed to serve the initial customers of its Storage Factory Project. This revised project will include natural gas facilities in the area of Frederick County, Maryland, along with gas transmission and storage facilities in other locations on the DTI system that will be necessary to provide service to its customers. As we develop a revised project scope, DTI will take into consideration the significant input that it has received from stakeholders who participated in the various meetings and public comment process.

I will send you a copy of the letter provided to FERC when it is filed early next week.
